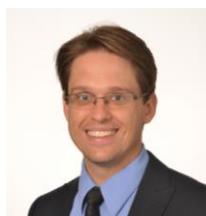

Abstract

Dr. Aric LaBarr is a Teaching Associate Professor in the Institute for Advanced Analytics. He is passionate about helping people solve challenges using their data. Previously, he was Director and Senior Scientist at Elder Research, and was for several years earlier a member of the Institute's faculty teaching classes in statistics, mathematics, finance, risk management, and operations research. Dr. LaBarr holds a B.S. in economics, as well as a B.S., M.S., and Ph.D. in statistics — all from NC State.



Dr. Alyson Wilson is a Professor in the Department of Statistics, Principal Investigator for the Laboratory for Analytic Sciences, and Director of the Data Science Initiative at North Carolina State University. Her research interests include statistical reliability, Bayesian methods, and the application of statistics to problems in defense and national security. Dr. Wilson is a Fellow of the American Statistical Association and the American Association for the Advancement of Science. She holds a Ph.D. in statistics from Duke University.
